CPT Code Resource for Healthcare Professionals Testing, Diagnosis, Treatment, and Management of adult OSA

Screening for and Diagnosing OSA

*95803	Actigraphy testing, recording, analysis, interpretation, and report (minimum of 72 hours to 14 consecutive days of recording)
95805	Multiple sleep latency or maintenance of wakefulness testing, recording, analysis, and interpretation of physiological measurements of sleep during multiple trials to assess sleepiness
95807	Sleep study, simultaneous recording of ventilation, respiratory effort, ECG or heart rate, and oxygen saturation, attended by a technologist

*Reimbursement for actigraphy varies from Medicare contractor to contractor and varies among private payers, as well. The sleep testing Local Coverage Determination (LCD) for the provider's region will indicate whether actigraphy is covered by Medicare in their locale. HSAT	
95800	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording; heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory analysis (e.g., by airflow or peripheral arterial tone), and sleep time
95801	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording; minimum of heart rate, oxygen saturation, and respiratory analysis (e.g., by airflow or peripheral arterial tone)
95806	Sleep study, unattended, simultaneous recording of, heart rate, oxygen saturation, respiratory airflow, and respiratory effort (eg, thoracoabdominal movement)

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HSAT	***G-codes are CMS generated temporary codes (The codes in most cases, carry higher reimbursement for providers)
G0398	Home sleep study test (HST) with type II portable monitor; unattended; minimum of 7 channels: EEG, EOG, EMG, ECG/heart rate, airflow, respiratory effort, and oxygen saturation
G0399	Home sleep test (HST) with type III portable monitor; unattended; minimum of 4 channels: 2 respiratory movement/airflow, 1 ECG/heart rate and 1 oxygen saturation
G0400	Home sleep test (HST) with type IV portable monitor; unattended; minimum of 3 channels

***The G codes (G0398, G0399 and G0400), which describe home sleep apnea testing (HSAT) services, were added to the Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) Level II codebook in 2008. Different insurers accept different codes for HSAT. Contact each insurer to identify which codes can be reported. To find the applicable reimbursement rate for the Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) for your location, go to your Part A or Part B MAC's website and find the current fee schedule.
